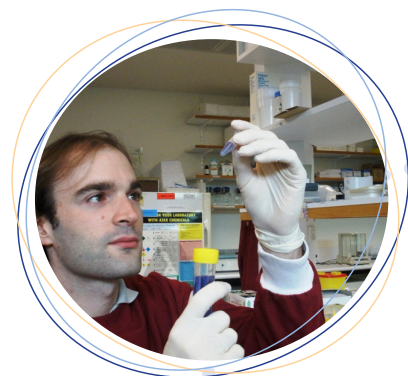

vi watson vacation scholarships

Vi Watson Vacation Scholarships are open to all Western Australian-based university students undertaking research projects relevant to asthma, who have successfully completed at least two years of a degree course or who have completed their degree (including honours degrees) in 2009. Apart from the overall merit of the application, factors taken into account will include the project's clear relevance to asthma, realistic goals and the applicant's personal responsibility for the project or a specific sub-study of a more comprehensive investigation.

A statement of the project protocol should be provided (collaborative projects will require separate applications from each applicant showing divisions of responsibility) and applicants will need to gain the acceptance of an appropriately qualified supervisor and the approval of the institution in which the work of the project will be undertaken.

Grants will normally be paid as a lump sum at the completion of the project and submission of a project report. Claims for the approved grant must be accompanied by certification from the project supervisor confirming performance in accordance with the project application.

Applicants are required to submit a registered copy of their academic record with their application form.

funding of \$200 per week is provided for a maximum of 10 weeks over the summer break
